



The village of Négrondes dates back to ancient times as evidenced by the prehistoric tools found in the town as well as a « peyre levadade » of which only the name remains.

Négrondes is crossed by the way of St Jacques de Compostelle (voie de Vezelay).

Let's go!


You are in front of the town hall, find and circle the 7 differences in the photo.

Turn left and go to the Memorial




What do you remark about the date?

Follow the red arrow. When you have your back to the Memorial, turn right on the main street.





Look up and on the next house on the left (just next to the yellow house).



Put these letters opposite in the right order to find the name of this window.

Continue your journey and turn down the next street on your right, rue de la fontaine.

When you get to the lavoirs, approach the fountain and look at the inscriptions above it. Note them in the square opposite.

Go up this road.


At n°4, you will find on your left a little opening opposite.



When arrived at n°50, you can obsere a window on the roof called "sitting dog". Draw below the element sculptered from the pediment.











Go to the church and go on its right. Observe the lovely openings on the houses next to the church.



Find the door opposite and write the date that is sculptured.




Go back on your steps, in front of the church and go round. Go in front of the Post Office.

Go past the Post Office and turn right into the main street.




Walk to n° 13.






Jog on to the n°6.

Along the wall that goes to the town hall. The stone opposite is found in the wall.




