




Welcome to Saint Front d'Alemps.

You are in front of the Town Hall (or place du 8 mai 1945).



Before you continue, you'll see a small sign on the right, note the name in the blank space.

On February 24 2012, this famous cyclist didn't pass the brigdge!

But one evening, on his way back from lunch, a local cyclist missed the bridge and fell into the stream!

The story didn't say if he was cycling without light or if another mysterious reason was responsible for this accident.



In many villages, the water supply arrived very late in the houses. Fountains like the one on the right provided water for the villagers and the animals.



Another fountain is at 50m away, note the inscription you will find on it.

Go to the crossroads and turn left, heading for the cross.

There is a statue in the stone, who is it?

Return to the road and walk a 100 m to find the main road passing through the village.



At the crossroads, turn left.



On the wall of the first house on the left are 2 old advertisements.

Another advertisement is above the « Palais de l'ameublement » Note the letter you see.

A little further on, on the roof of the house number 194, is a finial.

This flat bottomed niche is called an « enfeu ».

It is located in a religious bulding and is designed to hold a sarcophagus, a tomb or a representation of a funeral scene.



Walk to the croasroads and turn just before «Rue de l'église»

On your way, just before you turn behind the church, there is a house with blue shutters at number 33.


This bulding was one of the old post offices in the 1970s and housed the only phone in the commune.

Continue around the church. If you stand as shown in the photo, you'll discover something engraved on the stones. What is it?










For the record, several decades ago, some curious children went to take a closer look at the stone cross.

The postcard below shows you the « Place de la mairie » (the townhall square) as it was a long ago.



His door was always open.


Next door was a children's paradise!

When they got off the bus at the end of the school day, the children rushed to the grocer's shop to buy toffees and other sweets.


These treats were paid with coins earned from various jobs at the farm.


